*C. Dreamweaver Stencil, Paint stick, Translucent Embossing Paste, Swarovski Crystals, Bazzill Cardstock*

D. Dreamweaver Stencil, Versacolor Ink, Pearlescent Embossing Paste, Stickles Glitter Glue, Fiskars Greek Key Border Punch, Bazzill Cardstock

E. Accucut Candy Box Die, Little Yellow Bicycle Cardstock, May Arts Ribbon
