We also have the latest stencil designs of Two Cute Owls on a branch, large Crowing Rooster, two sizes of a Bunny, Swirl Fringed Heart and Large Damask. The large stencils work great for square greeting cards.

We have a limited supply of snack size Kraft color and dark chocolate color goodie bags. They look great stamped or stenciled and punched out with the Floral Tile anywhere punch, stuffed with a couple of



chocolates and tied with a matching ribbon. They make the cutest quick omiyagi or gift just for fun or thinking of you inspirations. Stop at the register counter and check it out.

Also imagine making a matching 3"x3" gift card or A2 size greeting card using the Floral Tile punch. I would call that totally awesome.

Covers, spine & 8 folios will be torn from one sheet of paper; then assembled into a book. Individual pages will be Deconstructed and Reconstructed to form YOUR unique book. Paper is individually painted by Pam (no sewing experience needed!).

Unleash your creative spirit to learn, share, and enjoy the camaraderie of like-minded souls---feel the synergy flow through the group!

We'll provide bottled water throughout the day. There are many great lunch eateries within walking distance, or a very short drive.

Optional supplies/tools: brads, eyelets, decorative paper, personal embellishments, yardstick, and punches.
